Peru is organizing a regional conference in Lima in order to exchange policies and strategies related to the reduction of Short-Lived Climate Pollutants (SLCPs) that are currently undertaken in Latin America and the Caribbean.

The meeting will highlight the main results and recommendation of the Latin American Regional Assessment of SLCPs and show the efforts aiming to reduce SLCPs emissions with a strong focus on the Regional Plan of Action on Atmospheric Pollution and the initiatives of the Climate and Clean Air Coalition (CCAC).

In addition, as a result from the conference, it is expected the leverage of regional synergies on SLCPs, for continuous exchange of experiences and lessons learned on the implementation of policies, programs, projects and an integrated database at the regional level. This will aim to promote the exchange of scientific knowledge, show progress on mitigation actions.

The conference participants will be officers of environmental ministries, implementers from CCAC initiatives, members of the Steering Committee of the Regional Plan of Action on Atmospheric Pollution and scientific community.
